**Note:**

- Overtime is paid using the Taxable Wage (Taxable Wage X Overtime Rate) then the taxable deductions (Dues and vacations) are deducted
- Training Contributions are based on 1.78% of the Drywall / Lather/ Taper Journeyman gross wages (Taxable + Fringe).
- Drywall / Lather / Taper Foremen, General Foremen and Superintendents are charged dues using the Journeyman wage rate.
- Union deduction (deduct from net wage) 4% of the taxable Journeyman Dispatch Wage of the applicable classification.
